- express your sexuality.
- communicate in your family's language.



You should be able to:

- make complaints.
- say you want to go to another provider.

- what type of worker you want.
- how you want things done.

We will always follow your instructions, unless we feel that you may get hurt, then we will talk to you or your trusted person about the risk.
